Regulations for the Allocation of Scholarships to Encourage Student Participation in the IEEE-LANANO 2026 Conference

Chapter I - General Provisions

Article 1. Purpose.

The purpose of this regulation is to establish the rules and procedures for the allocation, use, and accountability of scholarships granted to students participating as presenters at the IEEE Latin American Conference on Nanotechnology (IEEE-LANANO 2026).

Article 2. Beneficiaries.

Students who are regularly enrolled in undergraduate or graduate programs at universities, have good academic performance, and have submitted and been accepted to present papers or posters at IEEE-LANANO 2026, are eligible to apply for the scholarship.

Note: The participant who wants to receive a scholarship must pay the registration fee before applying for this benefit.

Article 3. Scope.

The maximum scholarship amount to be awarded will be up to four hundred US dollars (USD \$400), which may be used solely to fully or partially cover the following expenses:

- a) Airline or bus ticket to and from Viña del Mar.
- b) Accommodation in Viña del Mar.

Chapter II – Requirements and Application.

Article 4. Application Requirements.

Interested **students** must submit:

- a) Letter of motivation and commitment.
- b) Official certificate (or email-PDF) of acceptance of the presentation as a poster or oral presentation.
- c) Updated curriculum vitae.



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- d) Certificate of enrollment from their home university.
- e) Letter of recommendation from an advising professor or thesis supervisor.

Article 5. Application deadline

Applications must be submitted through the IEEE-LANANO 2026 congress website and will remain open until **September 22 or until the allocated funds are exhausted.**

Article 6. Evaluation.

The evaluation committee of IEEE-LANANO 2026 will assess the applications considering:

- a) The applicant's academic and professional merit based on their curriculum vitae.
- b) The order of priorities established in Article 7.
- c) Budget feasibility.

Note: Any special situation not considered in this document will be decided by the Scholarship Committee of the event.

Chapter III - Scholarship Assignment and Use

Article 7. Assignment Priorities.

For the purpose of distributing scholarships, the following order of priorities is established:

1. Graduate student with a FULL PAPER accepted.
2. Graduate student with abstract presentation accepted for oral presentation.
3. Graduate student with abstract presentation accepted in poster format.
4. Undergraduate student with abstract presentation accepted for oral presentation.
5. Undergraduate student with abstract presentation accepted in poster format.

Article 8. Assignment of Scholarships.

Scholarship assignments will be made according to the following criteria:

Scholarships will be awarded on a reimbursement basis according to the terms indicated in Article 3.



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Article 9. Responsibilities of the Scholarship Recipient.

The student beneficiary must:

- a) Represent the institution with responsibility and ethical conduct.
- b) Attend all academic activities of the congress.
- c) Use the allocated funds exclusively for the approved purposes.

Chapter IV – Accountability

Article 10. Accountability.

Once the congress is over, students **who have received scholarships will have up to 15 days to submit the receipts supporting the expenses to be reimbursed**, according to the terms indicated in Article 11.

Chapter V – Final Provisions

Article 11. Submission of documents.

Students receiving scholarships must upload all the required documents (certifications, proof of expenses, tickets, invoices, and/or receipts) at the ***IEEE-NextGen Expense Reimbursement (Concur)*** link:

Article 12. Validity.

These regulations will come into effect upon publication on the IEEE-LANANO 2026 congress website and will be immediately applicable.
